NDU-NAM Scholarship Application Guidelines

Deadline: May 15, 2018

Notre Dame University-Louaizé and the National Apostolate of Maronites joint scholarship offers college students who are active members of NAM the opportunity to spend a semester abroad studying in Lebanon. The Scholarship covers the cost of tuition and on-campus accommodations provided by NDU. In addition, upon receipt of a verification of enrollment form from NDU, the National Apostolate of Maronites will issue an award of \$500 to cover partial cost of travel to Lebanon. The current cycle will award scholarships to as many as <u>ten</u> students for Spring or Fall Semester 2019.

The NDU-NAM scholarship is awarded one time only, and only to those students who have not received a NAM scholarship previously. Once winners are announced, Notre Dame University-Louaize, in conjunction with NAM, will make arrangements to tailor a successful program of study for the scholarship winners.

All scholarships are in the form of a Certificate of Award issued by National Apostolate of Maronites, conditioned upon students' ongoing enrollment in an undergraduate, four-year degree program in an accredited college or university in the United States.

WHO MAY QUALIFY

In order to qualify for the NDU-NAM scholarship, applicants must meet the following:
☐ Be at least 18 years of age and currently enrolled in an accredited college or university in the United States.
☐ Be active members of the National Apostolate of Maronites and demonstrate a general interest in studying in Lebanon.
☐ Be citizens/legal permanent residents of the United States.
☐ Have maintained a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale.
\square Be enrolled in a major compatible with one of NDU's seven faculties and various degree programs.
Applicants with a proven academic record, leadership skills and NAM involvement are strong candidates for selection

of the scholarship. Financial need is one factor in the selection of scholarship recipients. Candidates must provide
