USEK-NAM Scholarship Application Guidelines

Deadline: May 15, 2018

The Holy Spirit University of Kaslik and the National Apostolate of Maronites joint scholarship offers college students who are active members of NAM the opportunity to spend a semester abroad studying in Lebanon. The Scholarship covers the cost of tuition and on-campus accommodations provided by USEK. In addition, upon receipt of a verification of enrollment form from USEK, the National Apostolate of Maronites will issue an award of \$500 to cover partial cost of travel to Lebanon. The current cycle will award scholarships to as many as <u>twelve</u> students for Summer Semester 2019.

The USEK-NAM scholarship is awarded one time only, and only to those students who have not received a NAM scholarship previously. Once winners are announced, the Holy Spirit University of Kaslik, in conjunction with NAM, will make arrangements to tailor a successful program of study for the scholarship winners.

All scholarships are in the form of a Certificate of Award issued by National Apostolate of Maronites, conditioned upon students' ongoing enrollment in an undergraduate, four-year degree program in an accredited college or university in the United States.

WHO MAY QUALIFY

☐ Be at least 18 years of age and currently enrolled in an accredited college or university in the United States.
☐ Be active members of the National Apostolate of Maronites and demonstrate a general interest in studying in Lebanon.
☐ Be citizens/legal permanent residents of the United States.
☐ Have maintained a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale.
☐ Be enrolled in a major compatible with one of USEK's eleven faculties and four institutes.

In order to qualify for the USEK-NAM scholarship, applicants must meet the following:

Applicants with a proven academic record, leadership skills and NAM involvement are strong candidates for selection of the scholarship. Financial need is one factor in the selection of scholarship recipients. Candidates must provide both a pastor and academic recommendation forms.

INSTRUCTIONS

Applicants are asked to fill out the attached application form and provide the following supporting documents:
☐ A copy of his/her college transcript from time of matriculation to date.
☐ The enclosed pastor recommendation form.
☐ The enclosed letter of reference from a college professor or advisor
☐ A passport-size face picture for NAM records. A digital self picture emailed to nam@namnews.org
☐ List of achievements in scholarship, leaderships, athletics, community service, or other activities may be attached-but avoid being repetitious
☐ Application of required facts
Upon selection, scholarship recipients will be asked to supply additional documentation to the Holy Spirit University in accordance with Lebanese and USEK procedures for visiting students. These include:
☐ Additional college transcripts.
☐ Proof of medical insurance coverage while in Lebanon.
☐ Proof of American citizenship or permanent residence.
☐ A copy of the student's passport.
☐ Two passport size photos
☐ A letter from the student's university including the courses he/she selected
Please note that your completed application along with the above required documents must be given to your pastor in order to reach the NAM Office no later than May 15, 2018.
All applications become the property of the National Apostolate of Maronites and of the Holy Spirit University.
